ENG1 MEDICAL

It is mandatory for anyone working onboard a boat to have an ENG1 seafarer medical fitness certificate whether you are a seafarer; in charge of a ship or are serving on a merchant ship or yacht.
The fee for the ENG1 medical examination is R3 200.00 and must be issued by a doctor approved by the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (MCA).

Superyacht Deckhand Course: (4 days)

You will learn how to effectively take care of a vessel by practicing key elements of any vessel's maintenance plan, which includes how to wash down the vessel, teak maintenance, as well as assess any damage of the vessel, correct product knowledge and application to repair the damage. Another part of the maintenance section focuses on woodwork and varnishing skills. Students will practice actual deck duties that are vital on vessels, such as navigational watch, guest on board protocols, line handling and anchoring duties to name a few.

Advanced Deckhand Course: (3 days)

The Advanced Deckhand Course runs over a duration of 3 days post the Superyacht Deckhand Course. The course covers more detailed subjects such as product and crew management, rigging, Superyacht topcoat finishes (spray and brush), fibre glass repairs, 3 different types of splicing, mooring operations of tenders and vessel, duties, and responsibilities of senior crew members and how to advance from a junior deckhand upwards. This course is aimed to broaden the skill set of crew, adding more valuable to their CV and in turn making crew more eligible for employment. Having completed this course will give you a competitive edge in finding your dream job.

Introduction to Efficient Deckhand: (5 days)

This course has been specifically tailored to give you a significant theoretical knowledge advantage over your competitors in the industry. As watch keeping is an integral part of being a competent crew person, a thorough understanding of the Collision Regulations, International System of Buoyage, and vessel identification during daylight and night hours is essential. You will also be introduced to vessel safety, GMDSS requirements, tidal theory and its implications, basic meteorology, vessel nomenclature, mooring, docking, and anchoring procedures.

RYA Radar: (1 day)

This one-day course gives you an understanding of radar as an aid to navigation and collision avoidance. During this course you will learn how the radar set works. How its adjustments and features affect the way it works, types of radar display, radar plotting and the use of radar in navigation and collision avoidance.

RYA Diesel Engine: (1 day)

This course teaches you how an engine works, basic checks and maintenance procedures and how to get it started again in the event of a breakdown. You will learn the principals of diesel engine operation, the system and parts of the engine, fault finding, routine maintenance and winter lay-up procedures.

RYA Competent Crew/ RYA Day Skipper Theory & Practical: (16 days)

During this course students will learn the principles of boat handling, rules of the road, sailing, crewing, navigation, and watch keeping. You will also learn rope work, knots, rigging, maintenance, and seamanship skills. After successful completion of this course, you will obtain a licence to operate a sail vessel under 24m – 15 nautical miles offshore.

RYA Yachtmaster Coastal/Offshore Skipper Theory: (7 days, Incl. SAS to RYA Bridging course)

This course equips you to navigate safely on coastal and offshore passages. The course will take your theory knowledge to the standard required for the RYA Yachtmaster Coastal Exam, concentrating on advanced navigation and meteorology skills.

This course will cover:

- Position fixing
- Course shaping and plotting and Passage Planning
- Tidal knowledge
- Use of almanacs
- Electronic position finding equipment
- Plotting weather systems
- Weather predictions using a barometer
- Collision regulations

SAMSA SRC/VHF Radio: (1 day)

The SRC (short range certificate) course is for anyone who wishes to use a fixed or handheld marine VHF radio. A radio is an important piece of safety equipment on board, and it is vital to understand the correct procedures. It is illegal to be in possession of a handheld VHF radio without a licence. The short-range certificate is the minimum qualification required by law to control the operation of VHF and VHF Digital Selective Calling (DSC) equipment. This includes both fixed and hand-held equipment using international channels.

RYA Personal Watercraft: (1 day)

This is an industry standard course as 98% of Superyachts overseas have watercraft on board such as jet skis and powerboats. You may know personal watercraft as jet skis. They are fast, agile and exhilarating machines that need to be operated safely and responsibly. The RYA PWC jet ski one day course is designed for both first time and experienced riders. The skills covered are launching, handling, and recovering, high speed manoeuvres, collision regulations and much more. This course is designed to be fun and informative.

RYA Powerboat Level II: (2 days)

The RYA Powerboat level 2 training course gives you the best of both worlds- your chance to drive someone else's boat as well as the opportunity to gain the experience and knowledge to be safe at sea. More importantly, you will come away understanding how boats work, the equipment you will need and the type, style, and design features that you would want on your boat should you decide to purchase one.
